2016 SAFETY MATTERS REPORT

HATE CRIME STATISTICS RUTGERS UNIVERSITY-NEW BRUNSWICK 2013 - 2015

2013: Two hate crimes were reported.

- One report of harassment (intimidation) within a residence hall indicated a sexual bias.
- One report of harassment (intimidation) within a residence hall indicated a racial bias.

2014: Six hate crimes were reported.

- One intimidation report on campus, which was within a residence hall; indicated a provocation based upon racial bias.
- One intimidation report on campus indicated a provocation based upon a religious bias.
- One criminal mischief (damage to property) report on campus indicated a provocation based upon racial bias.
- Two criminal mischief (damage to property) reports on campus, two of which was within a residence hall, indicated a provocation based upon sexual orientation bias.
- One criminal mischief (damage to property) reports on campus, one of which was within a residence hall; indicated a provocation based upon a religious bias.

2015: Eleven hate crimes were reported.

- One act of Intimidation was reported, on-campus, to have been motivated by a religious bias.
- Ten acts of Criminal Mischief/Vandalism (damage to property) were reported: including, three* (3) acts, on-campus, which were reported to have been motivated by a racial bias; six (6) acts, on-campus (including two within a University Residence Hall), which were reported to have been motivated by a religious bias and one (1) act, within an on-campus residence hall, which was reported to have been motivated by a sexual orientation bias.
